Sussex, NB – September 9, 2007 – Spotted horses came from around the Maritimes to compete in the annual Ronnie Wilkins Memorial Appaloosa Horse Show presented by the New Brunswick Appaloosa Horse Club. These colourful and versatile horses were shown in-hand and ridden in both English and Western riding classes.

Two shows were run concurrently, under two separate judges. This method of show organization allows competitors to enter more classes simultaneously and accumulate more points for their horses while, at the same time, saving on some of the travel and accommodation costs associated with attending horse shows.
